

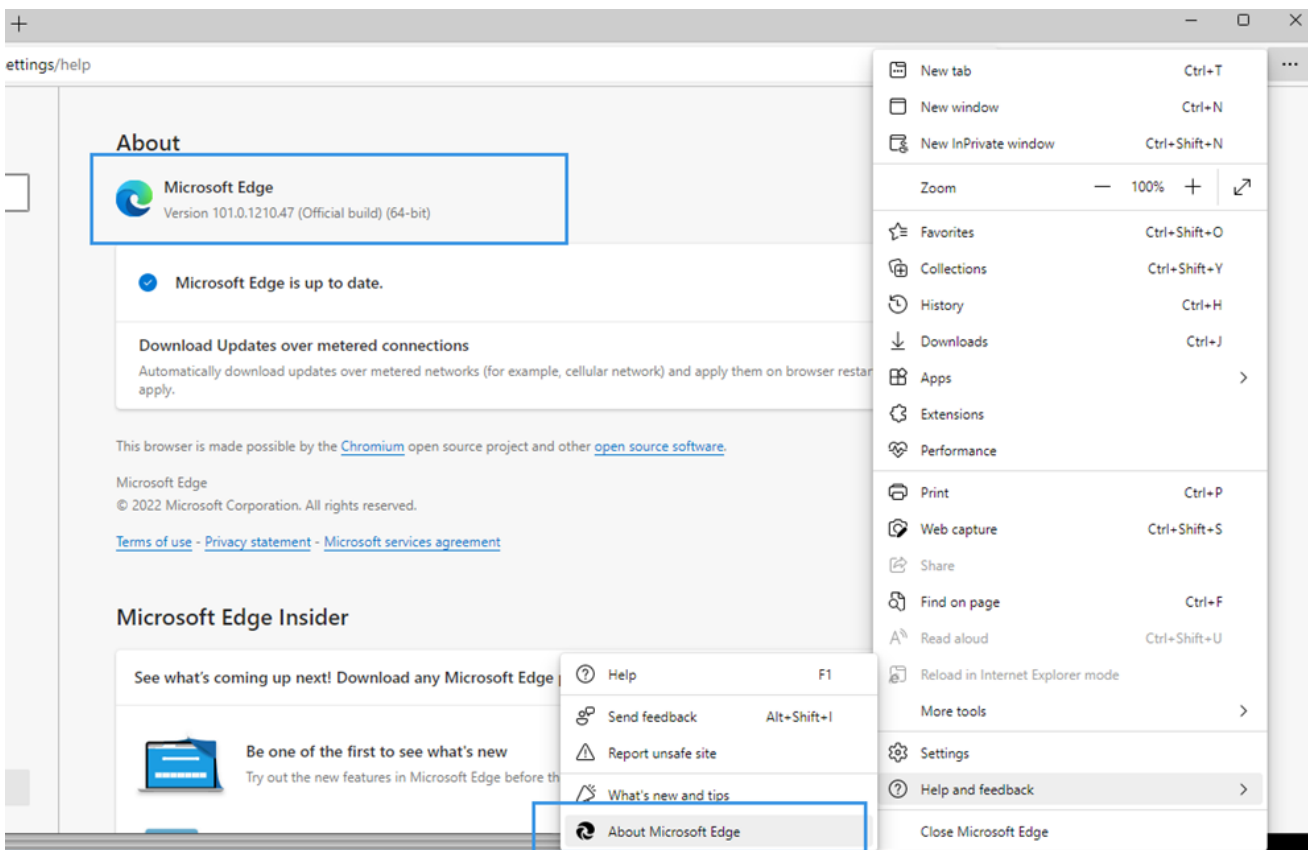
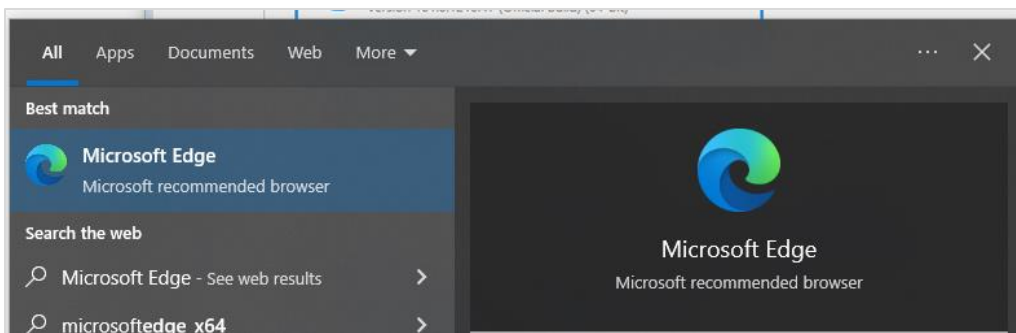
# Use EMS in Microsoft Edge with IE Mode

## Background Information

Microsoft is retiring the Internet Explorer (IE) and it will go out of support on June 15, 2022 [[Reference](#)]. **Microsoft Edge** is the one announced to provide backward compatibility of IE, but there are some steps to enable the tools in order to use EMS.

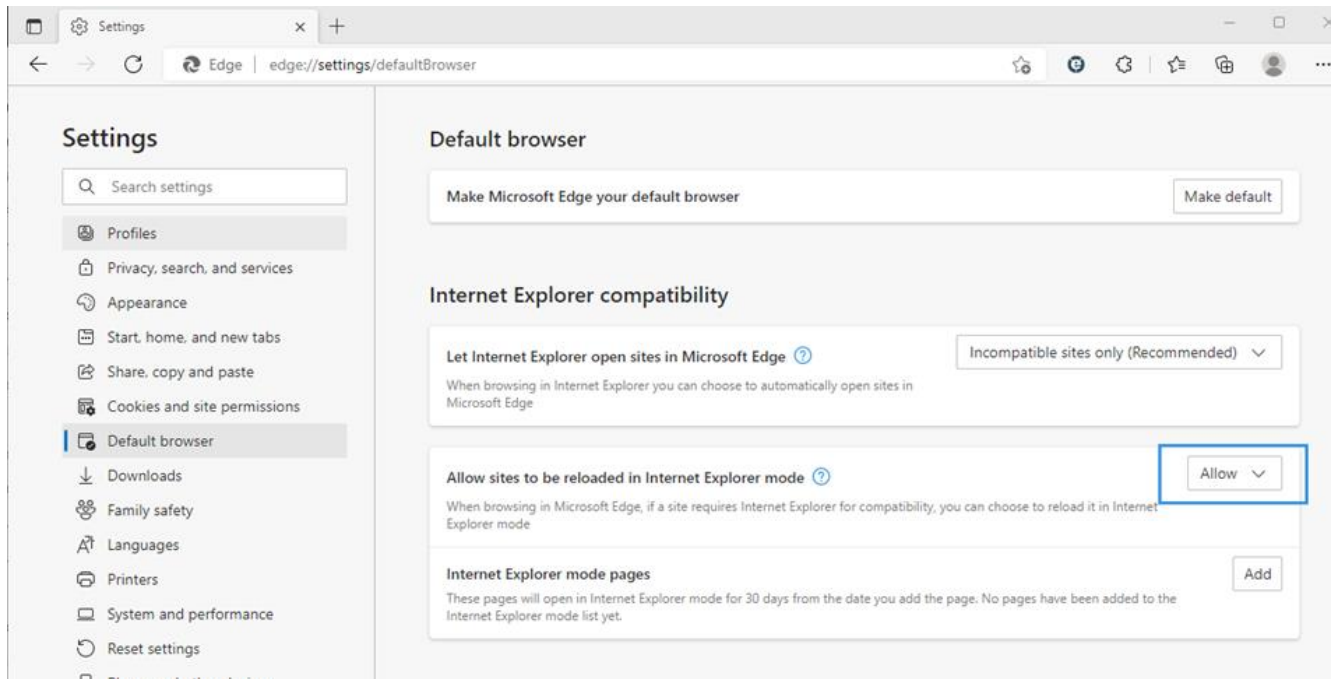
## Check Microsoft Edge version

Turn on the Microsoft Edge app and then check its version. The following method works with **Version 92** or later.



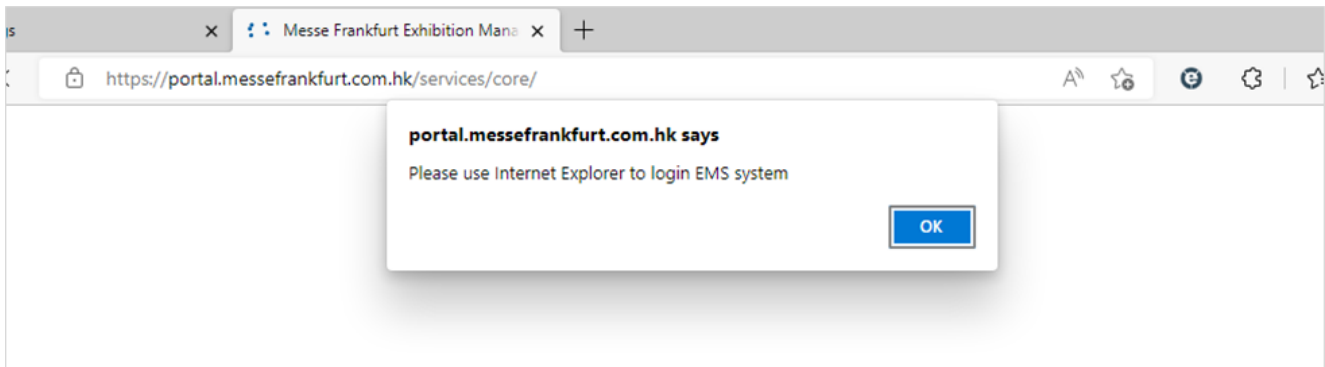
## Enable IE Mode in Microsoft Edge

1. Open Microsoft Edge and go to setting page directly with this link:  
<edge://settings/defaultBrowser>
2. Navigate to the **Default browser > Allow sites to be reloaded in Internet Explorer mode**
3. Change the setting to **Allow**
4. Restart Microsoft Edge



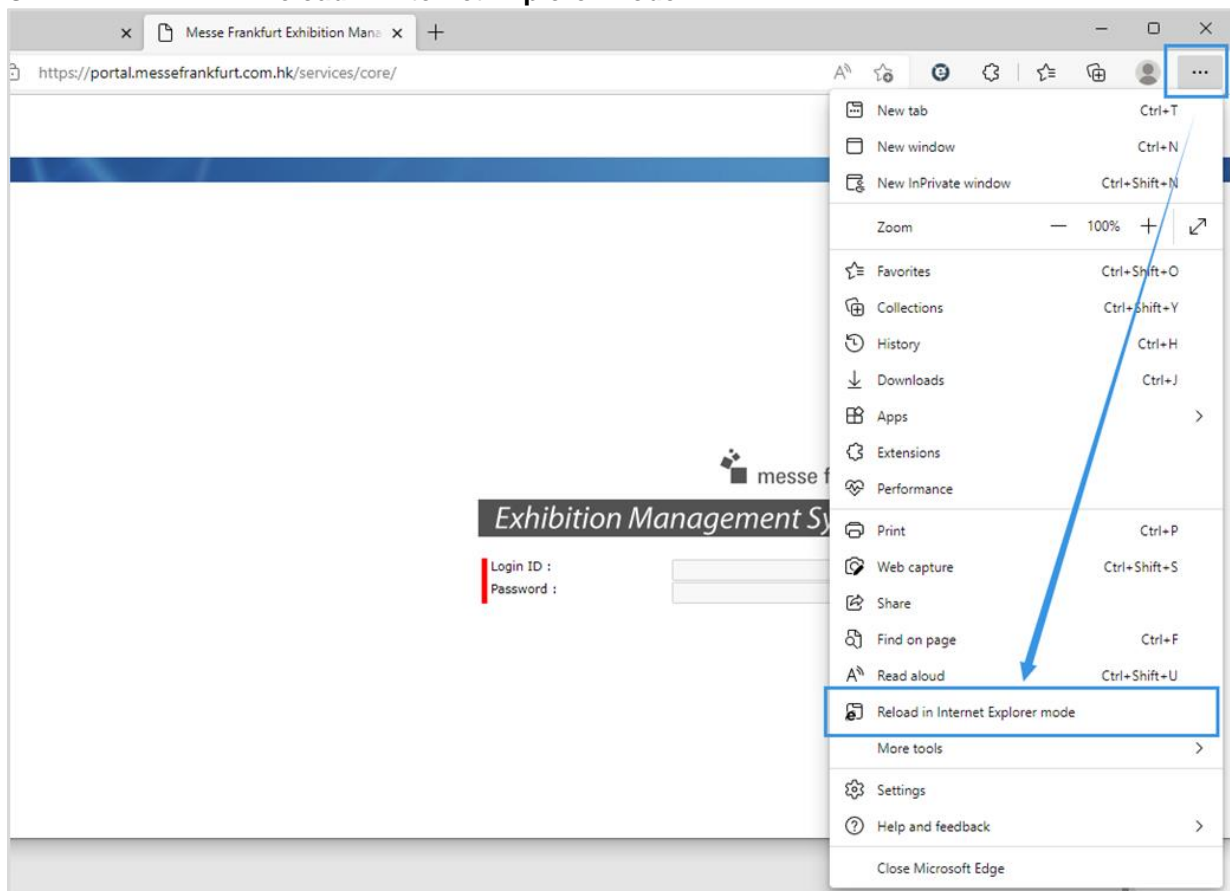
## View EMS in IE mode

Open a new tab and go to the EMS, the alert "Please use Internet Explorer to login EMS system" still there because by default it won't use IE mode to load a page.

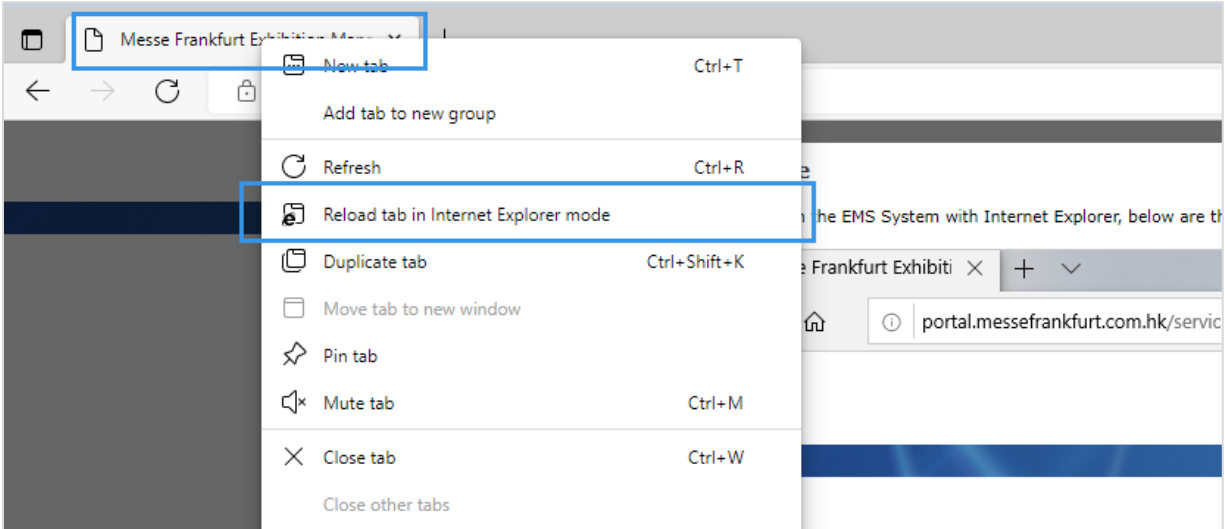


There are two method to refresh the page with Internet Explorer mode:

### 1. Go to "... " and select **Reload in Internet Explorer mode**

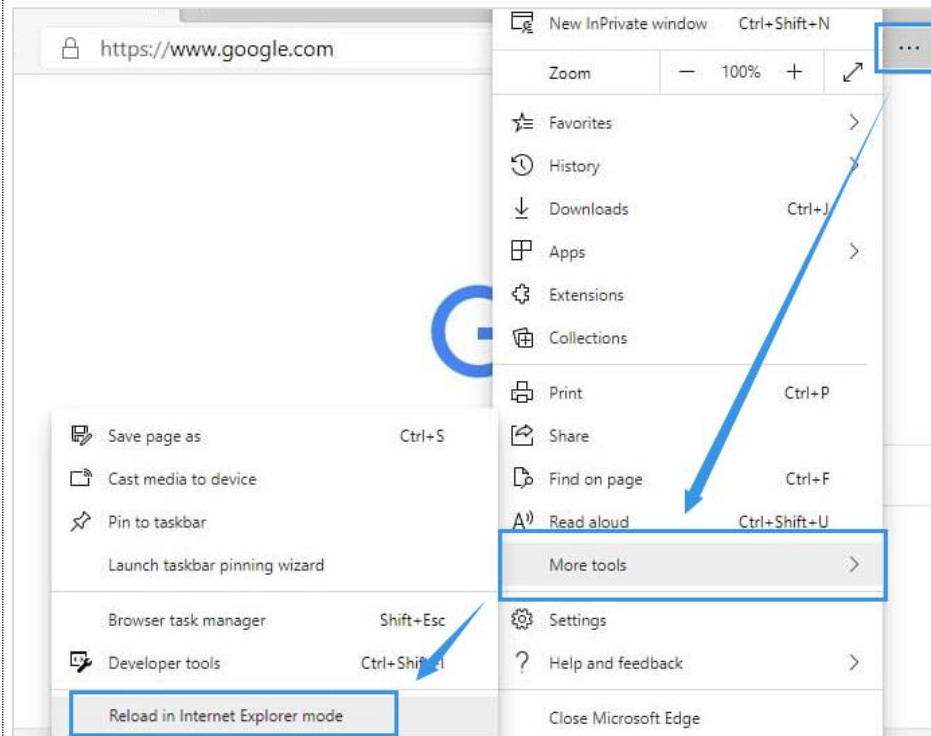


2. Right click on a tab and choose **Reload tab in Internet Explorer mode**

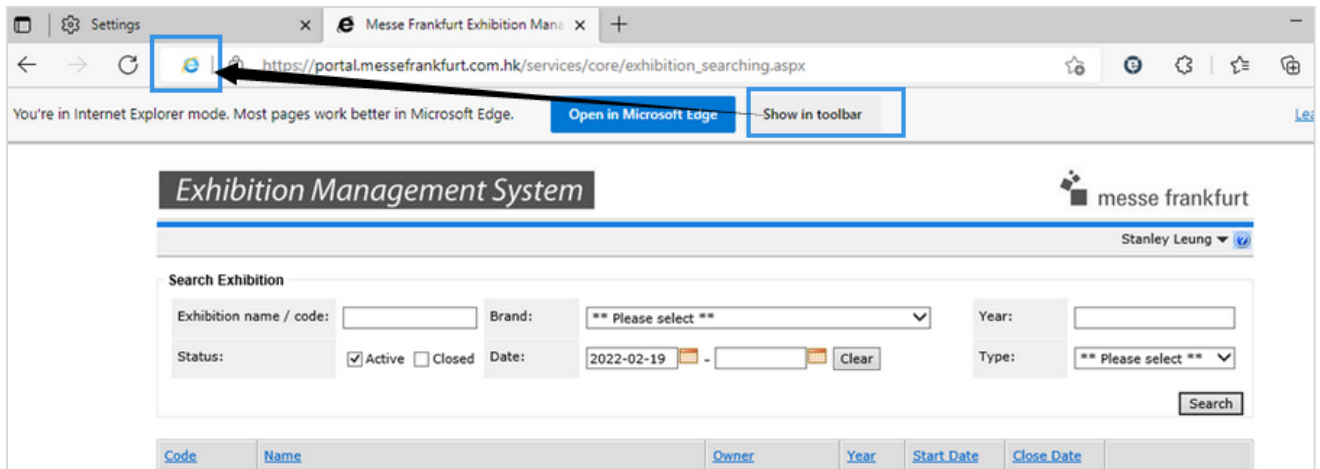


Older version of Microsoft Edge

Before version 100, the "Reload in Internet Explorer mode" option is inside "...> More tools



Once the page is reloaded, you can add the IE mode shortcut to the toolbar.
